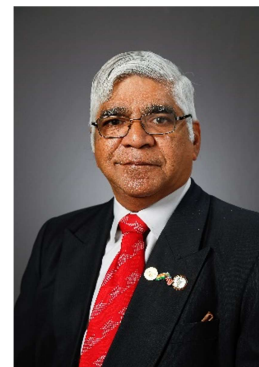

STEREOTACTIC RADIOSURGERY

Have presented number of papers nationally and internationally in this area. Responsible for helping set up several new radiosurgery units and training neurosurgeons.
